


Development of German Egg Market






Per Capita Egg Consumption in Germany






Development of the different egg production systems in Germany






Egg Purchases of Housholds in Germany











Future of the German market:

The situation:

- Ban of cages January 1st, 2007?
- Change of ban by new government?
- New developments in conventional cage systems (small group houses with 60 hens, perches, nest sand baths).
- Present production of alternative eggs 25 %
 Cages 75 %.
- Self sufficiency less then 70 %.

Future of the German market:

Expected future situation:

- Enriched large cages (small group hen houses)
 40 %.
- Alternative systems 60 % (50 % barn eggs, 45 % free range (high risk Al), 5 % organic eggs).
- Self sufficiency 60 % (perhaps more).
- Imports increase on low level for consumption but mainly for processing.

Future of the German market:

Expected situation after complete ban:

- Self sufficiency 30 40%.
- High imports for consumption and processing.
- Lower consumption, lost of many employees.
- Future of egg producer???
