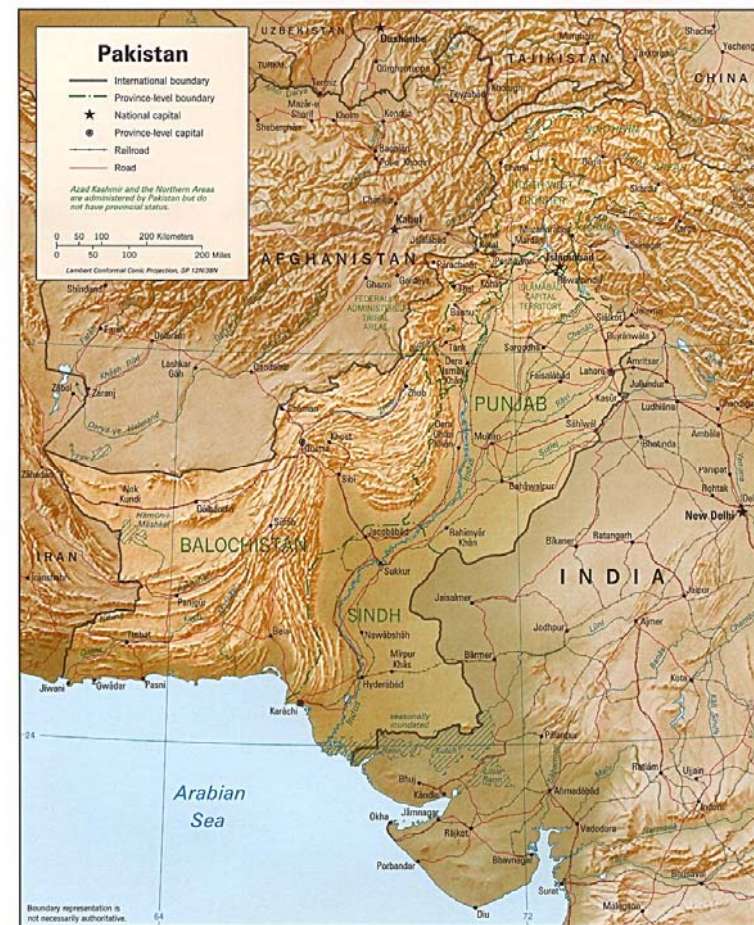

Egg Production

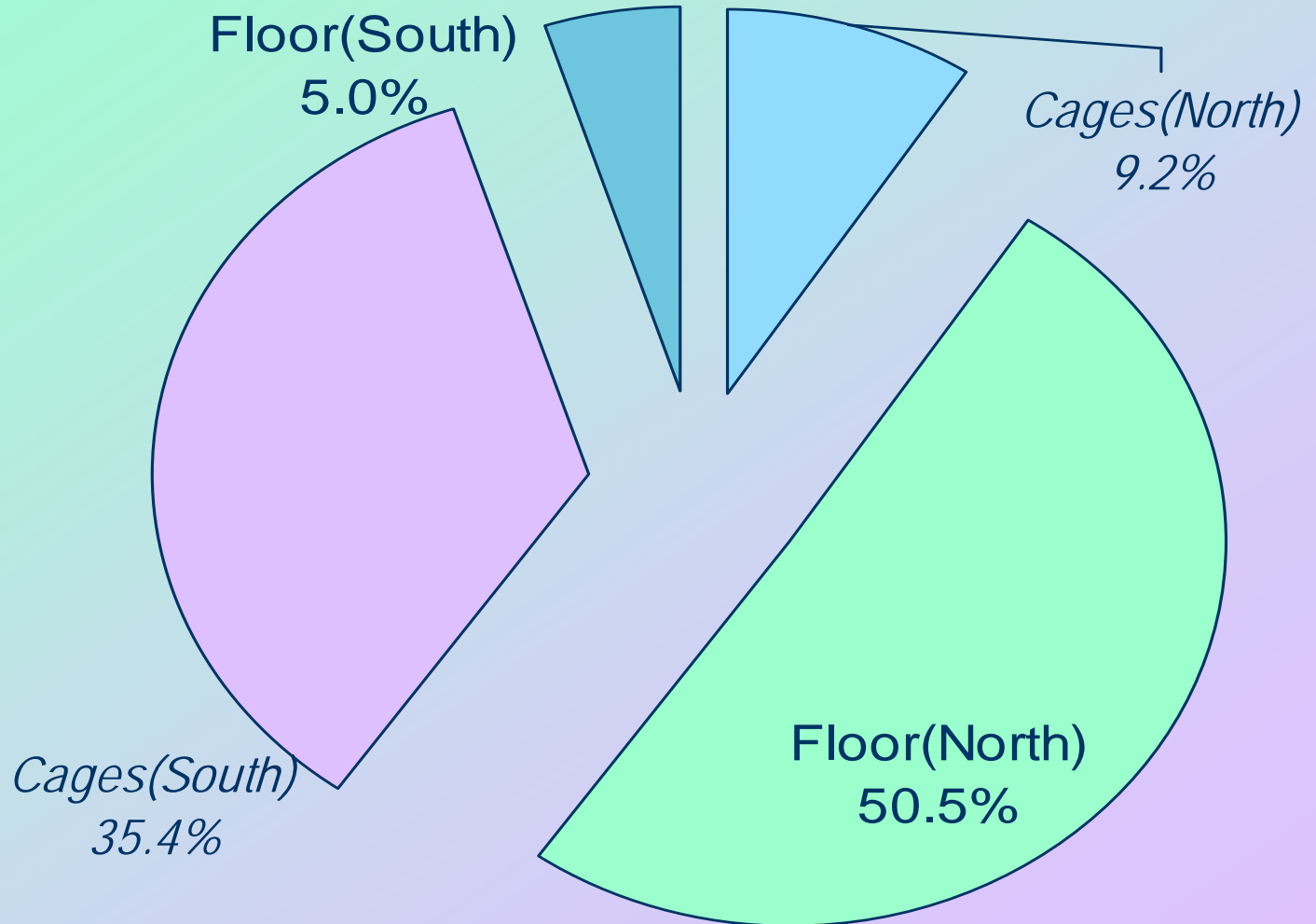


- Plastic Egg Flats to carry 30-Eggs are common in Northern part of the country.
- Eggs mostly come from Floor birds.

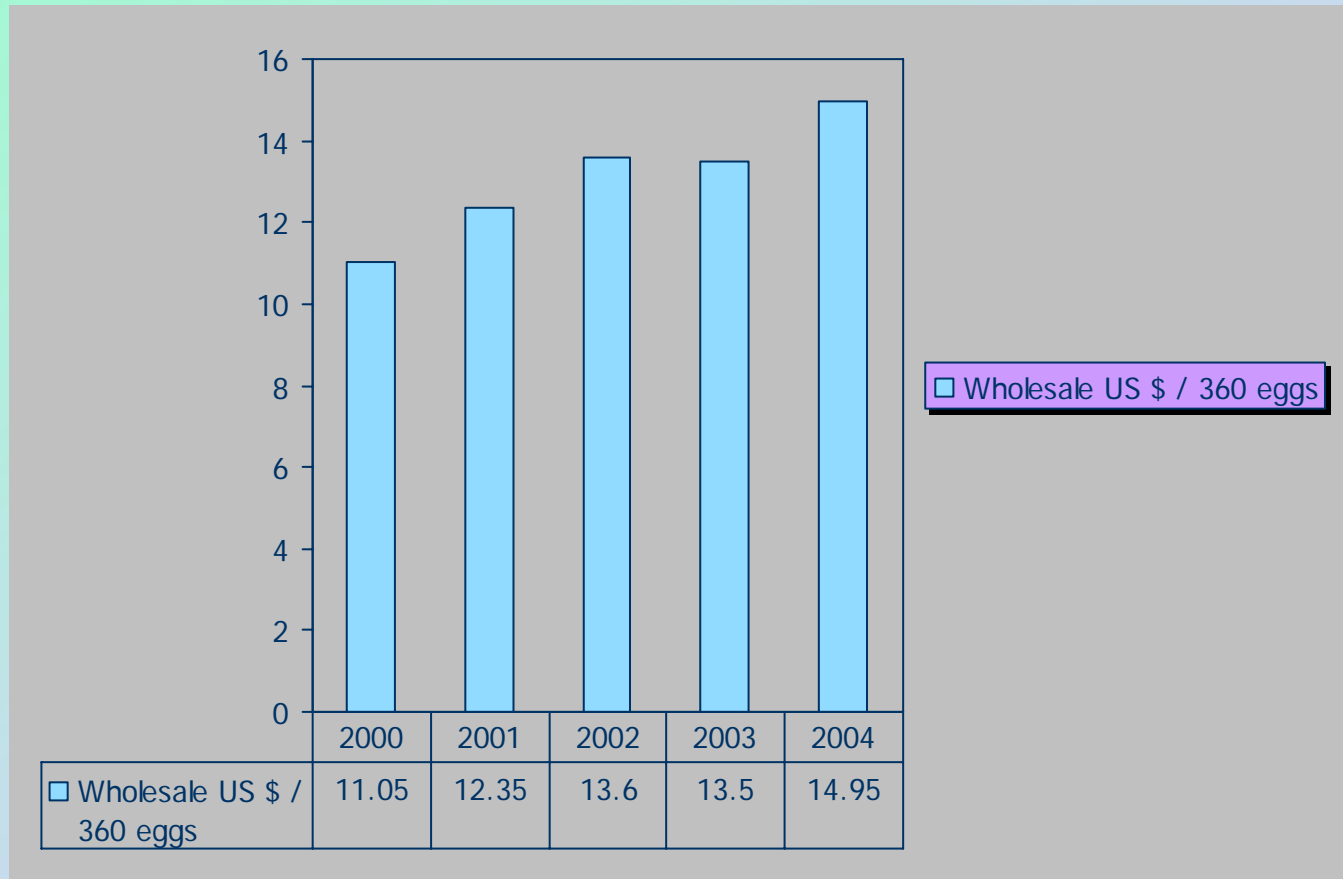


- Typical packing used in the South. Eggs are packed in wooden boxes with straw.
- Eggs coming mostly from Caged birds.

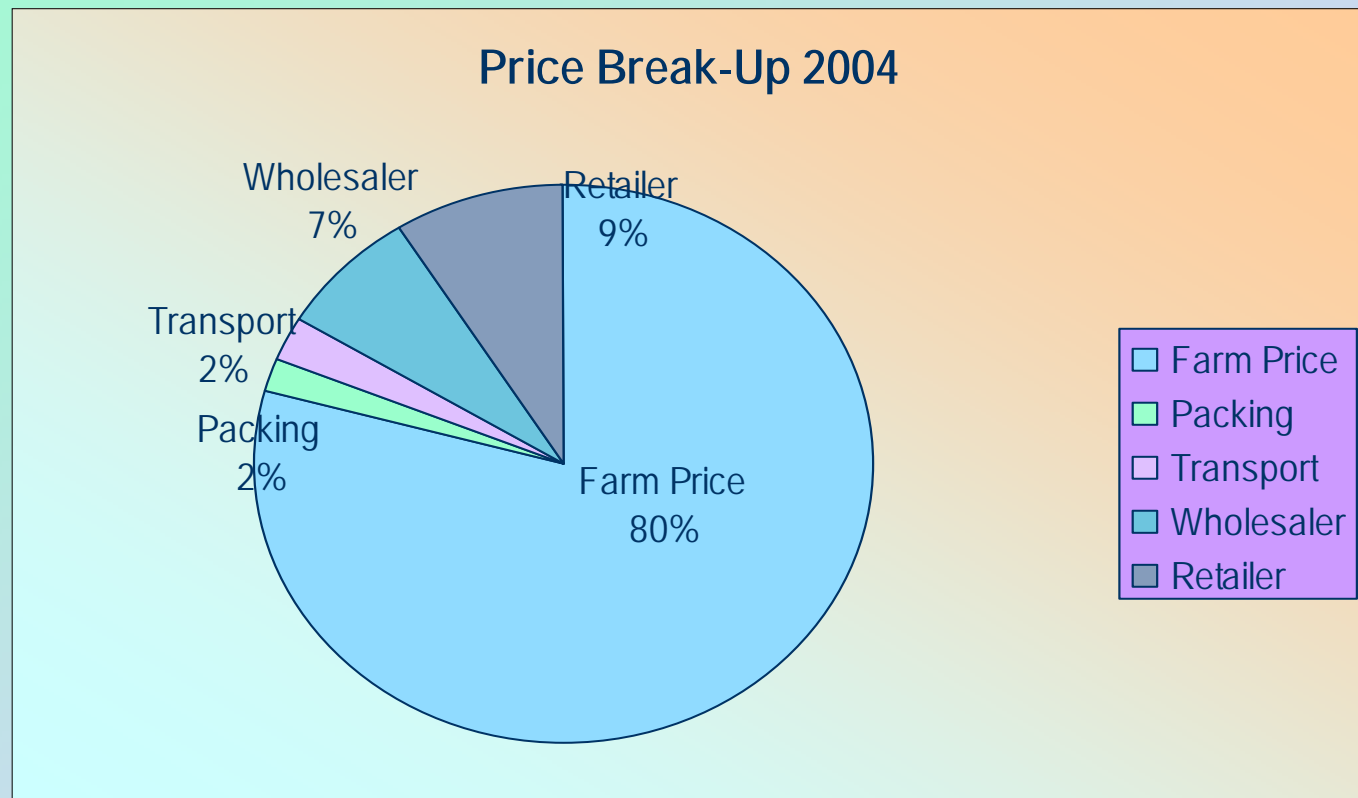

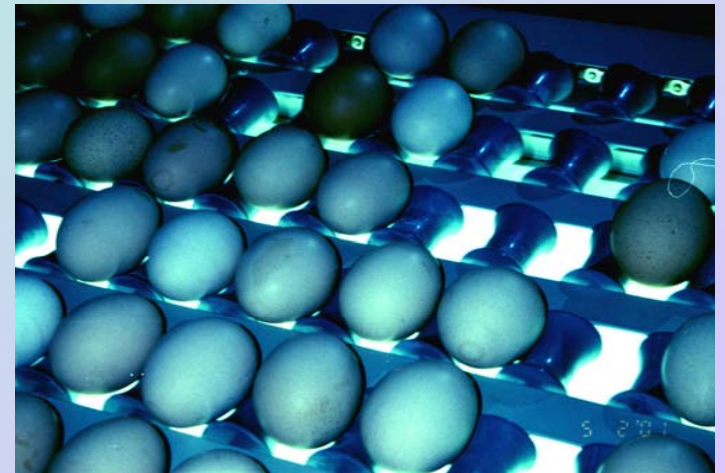

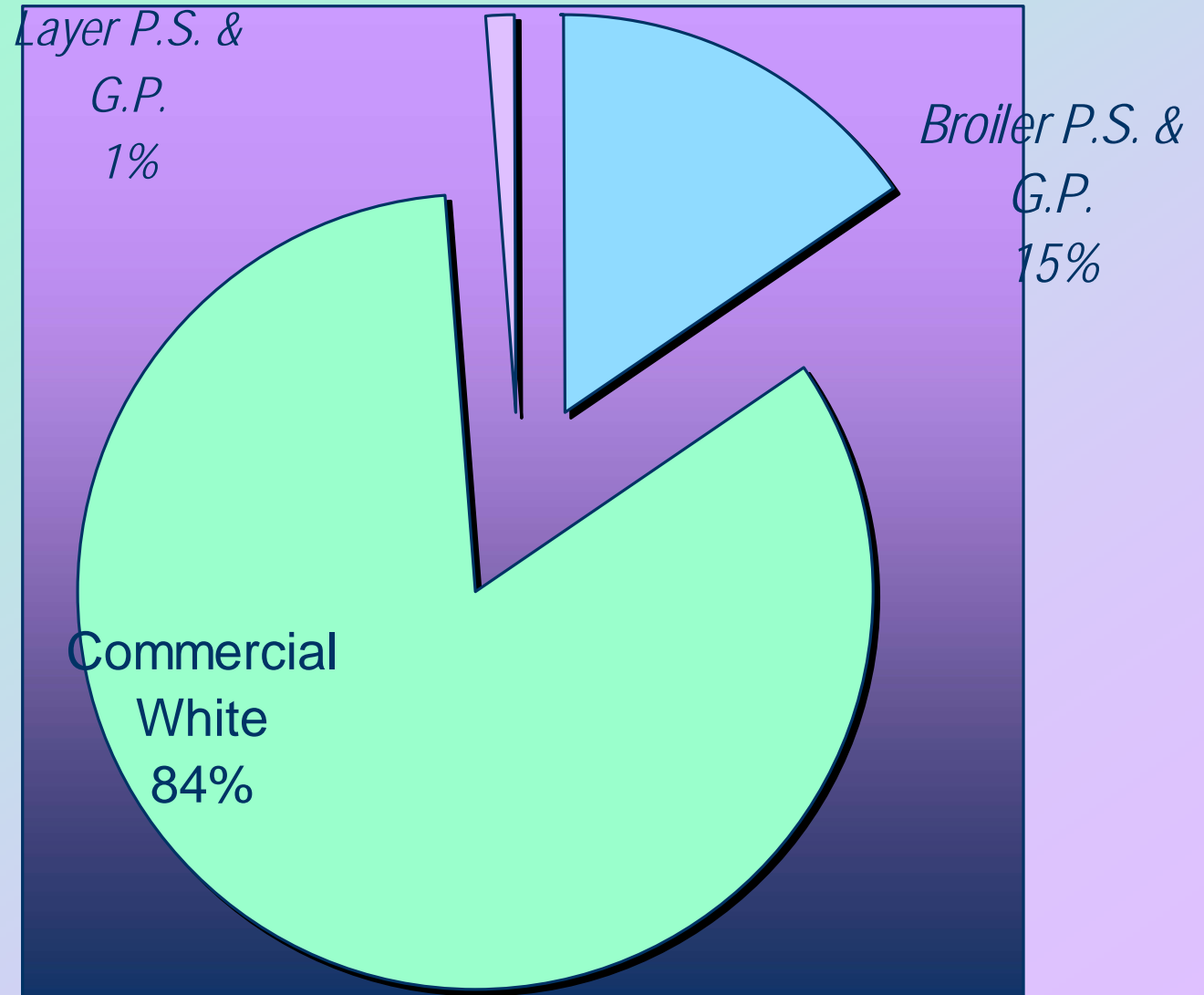
